



## **APPLICATION FOR ARTIST IN RESIDENCE POSITION**

Interested artists should read the Call to Artists and Program Outline, posted Oct 1 of each year. Applying artists must send in 10 digital visual examples of past work (approximately 10 x 14 inches at 72 dpi in JPEG format), evidence of online presence, letter of interest, resume/CV and two professional referrals. Applications are due by Oct. 31 of each year.

A selection committee — including two Idaho artists, a representative from the Idaho Commission on the Arts, and the coordinator of the ICL Artist in Residence Program — will review the applications and choose an artist with whom to work. Selection will be based on artists' work quality, professionalism, commitment to conservation and experience exhibiting their work. Artists will be notified of acceptance, or otherwise, by Dec. 1. The Artist in Residence term will last one calendar year.

The selected artist will receive a \$500 stipend upon commencement of the residency to cover some of the expenses involved in the creation of his or her work. An additional \$500 stipend will be given at the time of the final exhibition to cover some production expenses. The artist is responsible for expenses beyond these stipends.
